Overview:

Linden Hills UCC is an Open and Affirming congregation that actively participates in the vibrant and civic-minded Linden Hills neighborhood of southwest Minneapolis. - Plans and implements the Sunday School program, Ages 3 Kindergarten.
- Plans and implements the Youth program for children ages 6^{th -} 12th grade
 - o Manages development of a calendar and a planning process
 - Recruits adult volunteers in the church to plan/lead/support individual activities
 - Works with adult volunteers to plan a summer mission trip
 - Attends the summer mission trip
 - Leads fundraisers throughout the year
 - Provides oversight on the balance and content of Youth activities
 - o Plans and implements Confirmation
- Listens and engages young people and families in matters of faith to deepen their education and understanding of God
 - Works with Senior Pastor to plan and implement intergenerational worship services every 5-6 weeks
 - o Plans and implements special programs including family events
 - Works with the Music Director to include musical offerings in children's ministry and programs
 - Participates and is visible in Sunday worship including the interactive sermon
 - o Plans and implements the Christmas Pageant
 - Communicates with families of children in the congregation via email, social media and other methods
 - Participates in meetings of and advises the Board of Christian Education on relevant issues
 - o Explores and participates in the wider UCC denomination
